## From Bay Area, Points South

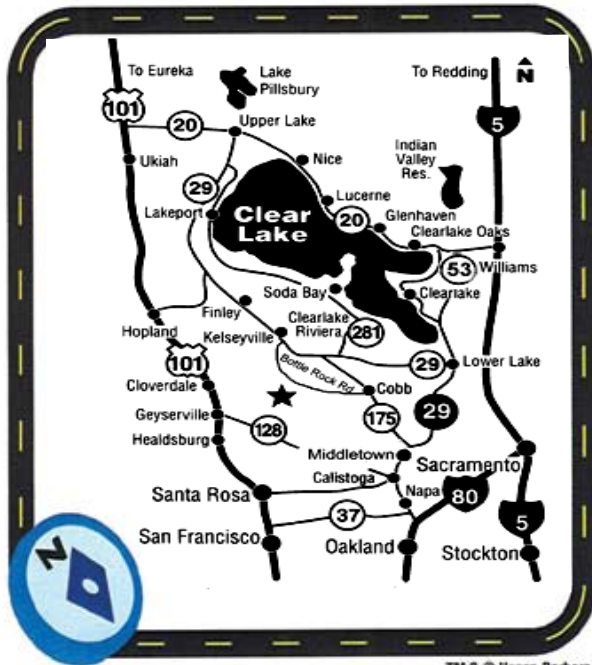
Highway 29 north to Middletown

## From Sacramento, Points East

Highway 20 west to Highway 53  
Highway 53 south to Lower Lake  
Highway 29 north to Bottle Rock Road  
Left on Bottle Rock Road for 7.5 miles  
Right into campground

## From the North, Points West

Highway 101 to Highway 20  
Highway 20 east to Highway 29  
Highway 29 south past Kelseyville  
Right on Bottle Rock Road for 7.5 miles  
Right into campground
